

San Marcos Youth Baseball (SMYB)

Play Up Protocol - Spring Season Only

Overview

San Marcos Youth Baseball (SMYB) recognizes that some players may benefit from participating in a division **above** their league-age group. To support player development while maintaining fairness and safety, the following **Play Up Protocol** applies **only during the Spring Season**.

Registration Requirements

Primary Registration is Mandatory: A player must first be successfully registered in their age-qualified division (the division their current age falls into). Only after registering in the primary, age-qualified division can the player then qualify to make a request to play in a higher division (e.g., registering in Pinto allows them to request to play up to Mustang).

Example: If the player's age qualifies them for the Pinto division, they must register for Pinto first. Then complete the submission requestions guidelines below.

Eligible Divisions

Play Ups are allowed in the following divisions:

- Shetland (6U) *Foal to Shetland is not eligible for play up*
- Pinto (7U–8U)
- Mustang (9U–10U)
- Bronco (11U–12U)
- Pony (13U–14U)

Submission Requirements

- All **Play Up** requests must be submitted using the official **SMYB Google Form**. Form will open on 11/1 along with registration.
- Deadline: Form will close when capacity is reached, as determined by the board but no less than 30 days prior to Spring Evaluations.
- A new request must be submitted each Spring season. Requests do not carry over. Only one division up
 or down may be requested per season.

Evaluation & Decision Criteria

Play Up Evaluations

- Players must attend evaluations in both:
 - Their league age-appropriate division, <u>AND</u>
 - o The division they are requesting to play up into
- · Attendance at both evaluations is required.
- Players will be evaluated and scored according to the league standard scoring system, relative to all other players in the division.

Play Up Approval Criteria

- Players must rank in the top 25% of all players in the older division based on SMYB evaluation scores.
 - If ranked in top 25%: Request is approved, and player is drafted into the older division.
 - o If not ranked in top 25%: Player is drafted into their age-appropriate division.

Top 25% is calculated from official SMYB evaluation results.

Coaching Restrictions

• If a player is granted a **Play Up**, their **parent or guardian may not coach** (head or 1st assistant) in the division the player moves into. You may assist as a 3rd or 4th assistant coach.

This ensures fairness in both the evaluation and draft process.
